Mathematics

Spanish

A fun way to learn this rich language. Anil's teaching is grounded in the fascinating cultural context of Spain. Students develop their skills with close attention to their individual needs. The classes are entertaining whilst maintaining focus on achieving very good grades. Homework is optional and detailed feedback is given. Anil has a 100% pass rate at GCSE (A-C) with 70% of students gaining A or A stars (8 and 9s on the new grading). All students improve by at least two grades after 6 months of study. His A Level students have similarly excellent results and he has also prepared students for Oxbridge examinations.

Students can join at any time.

All groups have a minimum of 3 students and a maximum of 8 students.

Homework is suggested but is not compulsory. Students decide how much they do.

All of our teachers are PGCE trained, highly qualified teachers with a proven, successful exam record.

We use meditation at the beginning and end of the class to help focus the mind and improve the capacity for understanding, assimilating and memorising.

If students choose two modules on a Thursday they can join the full school programme with yoga and meditation in the morning and participate in the democratic meeting.

Individual, detailed feedback is offered on all classwork and homework done.

GCSEs

There are two periods when exams can be taken. May/June or October/November (students doing IGCSEs).

Students decide when they want to take the exams, teachers can give guidance but ultimately it is the student's decision.

We are in the process of becoming a registered exam centre. Until then exams can be conducted at Woodhouse Grove School in Bradford.

Exam registration and text books are paid separately.
